#### **PROJECT DETAILS**

**Key Action 1: Learning Mobility of Individuals** 

**Project name: Natural Peace!** 

Project date: 27th of April – 7th of May, 2018

Venue: Boldogkőváralja / HUNGARY Organization: Kooperáció Egyesület

Participating countries: Croatia, Macedonia, Bulgaria, Turkey, Romania and Hungary

Number of participants: 5 young people +1 youth leader per country

**Age limit:** 16-22 (group leader can be up to 40 years old)

Participation fee: 20 euro/ person

### Summary of the projekt:

Five participant aged between 16-22 plus one team leader per country will gather together in Boldogkőváralja, Hungary between 27th of April – 7th of May, 2018, in order to learn and experience about solidarity and peace, improve their skills and some basic competences and build international network of friends. Participants are from Croatia, Macedonia, Bulgaria, Turkey Romania and Hungary, some of them are young people with fewer opportunities. After group building activities and discovering fears and expectations, we start working with our main topic peace, acceptance, inclusion and solidarity with a variety of activities such as small group discussion, theatre, simulations games and presentations supported with adventure games. Every group contributes to the exchange with an own workshops and an own national night. Continuous evaluations are built in the project, there will be evaluations every day plus one mid-term and one final evaluation. During the project, we will use informal and non-formal learning methods including adventure pedagogy. As a result of our project we expect improvement of the level of key competences of participants, increased solidarity and acceptance, enhanced self-expression, increased active participation and self-esteem and an increased awareness and understanding of other cultures. By the end of the exchange, we expect improved learning performance of young people and an increased motivation for taking part in future informal and non-formal education or training abroad after the project is over.

- We welcome if you bring the flag of your own country.

We will **NOT** visit cities, discotheques, museums, etc. We will have 6-7 hour activity per a day. We will build our small community at the accommodation, in a small village where we will live and in the nature. Hence, please be prepared and bring all the tools and clothes you may need in rainy weather: boots, raincoat (not umbrella!), pullovers, etc.(you can check the

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

By plane: you arrive to Liszt Ferenc Airport, Budapest, Hungary. From there you need to take a bus number 200E to until the terminus, called Kőbánya-Kispest – 11 stops. From there, travel till Kálvin tér with the metro number 3 (blue line) – 8 stops then change to metro number 4 (green line) and travel 3 stops to Budapest-Keleti).

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

Our accommodation will be the Tekerjes Fogadó in a small village called Boldogkőváralja. We will live in the tourist hostel section altogether. Rooms are 6-12 person/room, participants will be divided on the spot.



#### **COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENT**

The Youth Exchange Project is implemented with the financial support from the European Commission and the ERASMUS+ Programme. Accommodation, food, as well as activity costs will be covered from the project budget. Travel costs are reimbursed till the amount of money that is determined by the European Commission (see at "Travel Cost!"). Travel costs are only reimbursed if original tickets, invoices and boarding passes are given to the organizers. *If* these documents are lost or missing, we can't pay you back the money you spent for travelling.

Travel expenses will be covered after the project, when all travel documents from all participants will have been delivered to the organizers. Don't forget that for reimbursement we need original boarding passes, flight, bus and train tickets <u>and invoices</u>. Reimbursement will be done in EURO to the organizations, which will be calculated according to the exchange rates from official European Commission website.

#### **TRAVEL COST**

Travel costs were calculated according to the European Commission's Distance Calculator. We can reimburse participant's travelling costs up to this amount. Costs are not reimbursed if <u>original tickets</u>, <u>INVOICES and boarding passes</u> are not delivered to the organizers!
